I chased him and he bumped into me where I fell on the concrete sidewalk bloodying my elbow really badly, even with my coat on. I got up and continued after him for many blocks, up and down stairs, through stores etc. I called 911 but the first operator was no help. She treated me as if I was the criminal. I finally was so disgusted that I hung up and called again. The next operator did a great job and within minutes he had a police officer heading in our direction. Jeremiah turned around to hit me

An officer recovered the microphone. Praise the Lamb! Sadly, I found out later that this same Jeremiah just 3 weeks prior did the same thing to another preacher. Pray for his soul!

It was truly a wonderful time of ministering on campuses in California especially because the police and campus administration do not harass you there at all! Near the Bay, I was able to visit the **University of California Merced, San Jose State University, Delta Community College, Modesto Junior College, Turlock Community College, Cal State Berkeley and San Francisco State University.**

At Delta Community College we gave out hundreds of tracts. I started off the preaching and students stopped and sat down to listen. We took turns and the crowds got larger throughout the



day. I had many great 1-to-1's. It was sad to see so many students with gang like appearances, lots of tattoos and body piercing, died hair and stuff. There were professing Satanists. At one point there was a big uproar

when two female students started yelling at each other and had to be broken up by the police. A little while later, a woman passed out right in front of us during the preaching! We stopped, and I think it was all tied to spiritual darkness.

I was not too fond of, San Jose State University at first. It seemed that the students were very cold and not too many tracts were being taken. There were a few good witnesses later and tracts finally started being received. Brother Holes had a great witness with this one student, Anna. He received an email later from a Christian student named Jennifer who he encouraged to continue to witness to Anna after we left. Here is some of Jennifer's email: *"Well, I just wanted to let you know that your preaching really affected that girl named Anna. She is the girl that had all those*

questions and she was so broken over her sin. After you left I did what you told me to do and I got deeper into the gospel with Anna and told her the joy we now have of being in Christ and answered more of her questions. She

wanted to accept Christ into her life right there. Just thought you'd like to know that God truly was working." Amen! 1Co 3:7 So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase.
