There was an 86 year old dad and grandfather of a family from our Church who passed away on his birthday. Domingo is the Spanish word for, Sunday. Well, Domingo was also his first name. So we buried Sunday on Sunday. He had suffered a stroke about a year ago. I had prayed with and for him during this time. Because of his stroke I could not understand him but I could tell he understood and agreed about his trust being in Christ alone. I did not know until coming to our Church building on Sunday morning that I would be preaching his funeral to the nearly 100 that were in attendance. We placed his coffin in the back of the family's pickup truck and took him to the cemetery. There we screwed his casket shut, placed him in his grave and hand filled the hole with shovels.
