I was asked to come to the new police sub station in Las Flores, seen in the featured photo above. The station is just outside the Capitol line. We are working on a day of the week for me to come and have a time of preaching and prayer. I would ask that you keep this in your prayers. There is a number of gangs in this area and the police need God's hand of protection. One of the biggest challenges here in policing is the lack of funding. Some stations do not even have a vehicle or a phone line if you can believe that. Should anyone find municipalities that are willing to donate equipment for here please let me know. I believe this would go a long way to help save lives here and further the gospel.

This next Sunday 4-2-07, we will have many of our church family members visiting us. Especially our children's parents. We are having a special day planned with preaching, food and fun activities. The Devil's Drink:

As I was picking up kids Sunday I saw several men carrying the young man in the picture below. As they were moving him he looked lifeless and I had thought there was an emergency at hand. It turned out he was totally passed out from drinking. He was lying on the side of the road and the men who laid him in a hammock were fearing he would die in the heat of the sun. Sadly, many of the children standing around this man are a part of our church who live in this environment. I used this opportunity to warn the church of what the Bible says about drinking. Alcohol is a huge problem here in Belize. There are many drunks on the road either biking, walking or driving. Most of the car accidents here are alcohol related. Sadly if someone is to have his license revoked it is only lost for one year; afterwards they just get it back and can repeat the same steps again.





Chess Champs:

The boys took all the chess medals, AGAIN. They came in first, second and third place. Joshua, six years old took first place again with Joseph taking second and Josiah third place. This time the tournament was a qualification chess tournament. They now have all qualified for National Chess Olympiad 2017 tournament that is to be held on May 20th.
