I was told it should take about six months to reach the month we filed but that is just an estimation.

They spoke to our church youth one Sunday and the children really enjoyed their Bible lesson. Vance shared about being kind with our enemies which is something we always need to hear. We had a great time of fellowship which was refreshing for us all. Also, Mrs. Ruth from our church is a public school teacher who has asked us to come and speak at her school. Because of these two avenues we plan to go in weekly to the local schools. Please pray for these new outreaches.
