Recently in Belmopan there were two youngsters from B.C. that robbed a grocery store. Their ages were twelve and thirteen year old. They robbed the store at gun point and were later caught at the bus station trying to head back to B.C. Your prayers are needed as there have also been a lot of foreigners murdered in recent days.
