The doctors thought I would be dead and left me for dead refusing to give me a bypass. They said I couldn't go to Belize. Well here I am four years later and I feel better than when I arrived. Souls and lives have been change to the glory of God! All the doors that have open. All the people that said things could not happen, like coming without deputation, our work permit, permanent residence and such were accomplished. Satan has tried to destroy, but the key was to draw night to God and resist the devil and be steadfast. I am still here all by the grace of God!

CAR CRASH:

We recently had one of the worst traffic

accidents to be recorded in Belize. It left 7 dead, 4 Belizean's and three tourists. Former Assistant Commissioner of Police, Eduardo Wade and his daughter Forty-five-year old Lourdes Wade died in the crash. As a Police Chaplin here I was there to offer prayer and condolences to the police for the loss of their former colleagues.



I also minister weekly to the Social Security Board (SSB) and was called in as they held a special service for Lourdes Wade who worked there. I sang, played my guitar, spoke and prayed. There was about 200 gathered and I was delighted to hear many pray to trust in Christ at the service. I also prayed in the back offices for coworkers who where seriously grieving. The next day the CEO of the SSB stopped all operations so we could pray. I mean there was the general public inside the SSB waiting in line and he announced that we were going to pray. It is hard to comprehend because I know that would never happen in the USA and if it did, there would be a lawsuit filed. It was a great honor to have this opportunity and I would ask that you pray for those grieving from the loss.
