Belize Locked Down:

I believe you would agree with me that I could not have imagined all that happened durning the COVID pandemic. The Lord's timing in having us take our first furlough spared us greatly!

Belize went on extreme lockdown far worse than the US after we left. So much that they enforced a curfew and no one could leave their homes or be arrested; still, over 1,300 people were. The boarders closed. The bus lines all shut down, which is most Belizean's means of motorized transportation. The lines at the food stores were extremely long and food shelves emptied down to flour, rice and beans. In addition, the drought conditions from last year continued. The heat soared into the 100's and there were so many forest fires and weeks of lingering smoke that they passed new national laws on burning. The good news is only 18 total have been reported infected with two deaths. Still many are hurting with no

I wasn't sure how things would continue with the Church durning our furlough. I was very pleased to hear that they still continued to meet after we left before the shut down. In fact they were meeting even durning the shut down and had to hide one time when the police drove by. They were in the new building that is 300 feet from where we used to meet. The building does not have any walls and could have easily been see so I am thankful they were not confronted. Once I heard this I advised them not to take that chance any further.
