HURRICANE ETA:

On top of the flooding I reported about last time, Belize was hit by flooding due to hurricane Eta. After Eta made a direct hit in Honduras, it turned North and moved through Belize dumping severe rain fall. The picture to the right shows the new bridge almost covered by the flooding. The old bridge and police station next to it were completely covered by water. The turquoise color roof buildings that are on the left





side of these pictures is the agricultural show-grounds property where we witness and pass out tracts every year to thousands in attendance. You can see that it is completely submerged by flooding. In less than 2 weeks after Eta, Belize was also hit with more rain from Ida then received some rain from Tropical Depression Lota. Thankfully all our church family there made it safely through this. Praise God!

Belize COVID:

I reported last time that Belize had 5 deaths and 562 active cases. It has now risen to, 120 deaths and 5,249 active cases. Please remember Belize in your prayers because they are not equipped to handle this pandemic like we are. I am definitely thankful to be here on furlough durning this time. My doctor said if I catch COVID it likely will be fatal for me given my underlying health condition. I know WHO holds life in His hand and trust Him!

CHURCH UPDATE:

Speaking of COVID, Brenda Correa, whose was an aunt of some of our church family members in Belize passed away on November 23rd from Covid-19. She was only 27 and had a 7 month old baby girl plus 3 other children. Please remember to keep her family members in your prayers. Out side that, I hear all is well there. They had a new baby dedication recently and the children are continuing to come and participate. This all blesses my heart!

BELIZE ELECTION:

Belize elected a new Prime Minister (P.M.) Johnny Briceño this month. Thankfully the government of Belize withdrew an *Equal Opportunities Bill* in September after church leaders objected to the government placing the civil rights of gays and lesbians above the rights of religious believers. The former Prime Minister Dean Barrow wanted it passed and I am hoping that the new P. M. will oppose it when they try again. Briceño has just tested positive for COVID-19. Please pray for him and his leadership.
