All attempts with other medication's have failed to get me off prednisone. With your prayers and this procedure, I am hopeful that I will be able to get off it, or at best, reduce my dose. This will be taking place, October 30th to November 4th. Please pray for my travel, the treatment and medical doctor's wisdom! Eight days later the transmission arrive and one month later it was installed. after a second attempt to pick it up, the mechanic told me the new transmission he put in was no good. A replacement was supposed to come in within a week. I did not believe it and was not going to wait another month so I ordered a used one which arrive the next day. I picked up our vehicle two days later and drove over an hour away only to find out it was leaking a pencil size stream. I took it back to the shop and picked it up late in the afternoon the next day. Yes, I was still thanking the Lord and share the gospel to him people I never would have if this has not happened. Thank you Jesus! I could really use help paying for this to if the Lord purposes it in your hearts.

I am hoping we can land back in Central America by the end of November or early December. We will hit the ground running! There are lots of things to do. We plan to expand up into Mexico this year now that the borders are open again. My plan is to be on the border where my kids can learn Spanish and I can minister in Mexico and Belize.
