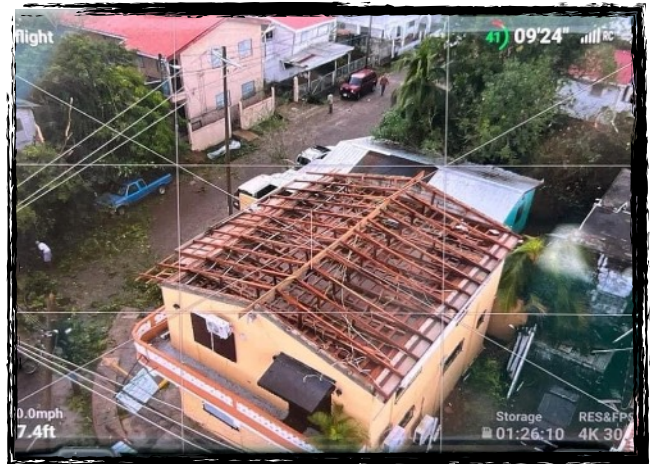
HURRICANE LISA HIT BELIZE:
