Last month I had another missionary reach out to me letting me know he had boxes of Bibles. He was heading to Mexico and asked if I thought people would take them. As it turned out, I referred him immediately to them and he handed the boxes over to them. Praise our Lord for His mighty works!



HEALTH UPDATE:

I've had quite the health battles these last few months. I should have sent out a prayer request but I can get stubborn sometimes.

I got one surgery, out-ofthe-way and some other medical issues taken care of which is helpful before returning. I also had Cat Scan Angiogram's of my head and neck along with carotid artery ultrasounds. Normally the Doctors want me to have these every 6 months and it had been 3 years ago since my last one. I did get some peace of mind because the tests showed that there was no change compared to my 2017 scans! I was thinking that my arteries may have closed down even further due to the prolong illness I had last winter so I was very relieved there was no negative change. My left subclavian artery is still 100% closed and my right severely narrowed. My left common carotid artery 100% closed and my right about 80% closed. Jesus Christ is sustaining me, so I must still have work to do!

In August, I had a little piece of what I believe was an insulation fiber fall into my left eye, which I promptly flushed out. However, after about two days, it was getting worse and I went to the eye doctor thinking something was

lodged in there. I'm glad I went because the doctor said it was one of the most serious eye problems that a person could have. It is called a, nodule scleritis. He told me if it ruptured he

would have to do a patch and if that did not work, they would remove my eye completely. I ended up going as high as 70 mg. of prednisone. In September, I started reducing my prednisone only for it to come back again and have to increase. This delayed my plans to return to Belize but I'm happy to report it seems to be doing good, although it is still noticeable.

My rheumatologist recently called me, and said that he had found a medication that might help me get off of the prednisone. He's concerned the prednisone is going to kill me. "Man Proposes,

God Disposes. Nevertheless, he wants me to start this medication in the spring. The only catch is that it requires an injection which needs to be kept refrigerated. That will make it difficult being

in Belize, but we will see what develops. All this is an experimental drug so please pray for the best outcome in this regards.

I felt at peace and purchased our plane tickets for December 11th. Please prayer for our travels and I'll be in touch after we arrive.
